

CURRICULUM POLICY

Rationale:

- Implementation of the Victorian Curriculum across the school will provide all students with a sequential curriculum framework that guides their learning, as well providing measures of learning achievement that allow students, teachers and parents the opportunity to assess student performance against standardised learning outcomes.

Aims:

- To improve student learning through the implementation of the Victorian Curriculum across all Domains and across all year levels in a manner consistent with departmental requirements and locally identified needs.

Implementation:

- The school is committed to the implementation of Victorian Curriculum throughout each Domain, and across all year levels.
- A senior staff member will be allocated the responsibility to lead a team in the development and implementation a strategic plan for the integration of Victorian Curriculum across the school.
- In doing so, all DET timelines and reporting requirements must be met.
- Whole school professional development opportunities will be provided, as well as personal professional development plans developed that cater for the Victorian Curriculum needs of each staff member.
- The strategic plan and annual implementation plan will outline the purpose of teaching and learning to ensure staff and school stay aligned to Victorian Curriculum assessment and reporting requirements
- Student achievement will be measured and reported to students, parents, DET and the wider community against Victorian Curriculum achievement levels.
- All staff will participate in the collection of student achievement data, and all staff will have input into school direction decisions resulting from interpretations of student achievement data.
- Implementation of Victorian Curriculum will be a key performance indicator of each staff member's annual performance review.
- School council will provide adequate resources for the implementation of Victorian Curriculum and associated professional development etc.

Evaluation:

This policy will be reviewed every three years as part of the school's three year review cycle.
